Wilderness Adventures gives older campers an opportunity to take their outdoor skills to the next level and develop important team-building skills. By allowing campers to immerse themselves in a more in-depth discovery of the forest, we hope to encourage a deeper understanding and appreciation of the wilderness areas of East Texas. On Monday campers will practice their outdoor skills and knowledge, experience the rock wall climbing and participate in team building activities at Campus Recreation coordinated by SFA Outdoor Pursuits. On Tuesday the group will travel to Lake Naconiche for a full day of basic canoeing training. Wednesday we head to the woods of East Texas to set up camp and explore nature. On Thursday the group canoe adventure begins as we go on an all-day canoeing river trip. After a full day of canoeing, the group will return for campfire cooking and fun. By the end of their camp time, it is our hope that campers will gain greater appreciation and stewardship values for the natural world.
